Bobby E. Crouch, 91 , died Thursday, February 24, 2022 at Self Regional Healthcare in Greenwood.

Born in Saluda County and a son of the late, Bennie Belton and Sudie Elizabeth Schumpert Crouch, he was the husband of the late Lou Frances Riley Crouch. Mr. Crouch was a graduate of Saluda High School and was a retired supervisor from Saluda Knitting Mill. 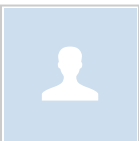
