Floyd William "Bub" Crouch passed away Wednesday, March 4, 2015. He was born November 24, 1927 to the late John Floyd and Bernice Derrick Crouch.

"Bub" graduated from Saluda High School where he played football. After graduation he was employed at the Palmetto Hosiery Mill in Saluda. In 1951 he was drafted into the army and served in the Korean War with the 45th Infantry Division until 1953. He returned to his job at the hosiery mill until it closed. He then went to work for Edwards Oil Company where he was employed for 42 years.

He was a member of the American Legion. He was a lifetime member of Gassaway United Methodist Church where he served on the Board for several years.
