Hubert Raymond Bryan, 91 of 2066 Greenwood Hwy., died Friday, April 1, 2016 at Saluda Nursing Center after a brief illness.

Born in Saluda County, he was the son of the late Olin Ellis Bryan and Emmie DeLoach Bryan. Mr. Bryan retired as owner and operator of Bryan's Used Cars and Store. He was a WWII Veteran and was wounded in France and was awarded a Purple Heart and a service medal with three bronze stars. He was a member of Good Hope Baptist Church.

He is survived by a sister, Deloris Bryan Moore of Greenwood and nieces and nephews.

Mr. Bryan was preceded in death by six brothers, Horace, Vernon, Jack, Dwight "Preech", Melvin and Leonard.
