Louella Cromer Crouch, 92 of Saluda, widow of John David Crouch, went to join her Lord and Savior on 26 August 2024. She passed away with friends and family by her side at Saluda Nursing Center.

Born on April 20th, 1932, Louella was the daughter of the late Henry Cromer Sr and Eliza Riley Cromer. She was a graduate of Hollywood High School. She was also a member of the Hollywood High School State Championship Basketball teams for the years of 1947, 1948 and 1949.

After high school, she married her love, John Crouch. They were happily married for 64 years. She retired from the Saluda Shirt Plant. She also later retired from Hollywood School as a school bus driver and a cafeteria worker. In addition, she worked in the cafeteria at the Saluda Nursing Center.

She was a member of Bethany Methodist Church, Bethany UMW, Antique Teenagers and Woodmen Life. She was a dedicated Hollywood Ruritan wife and devoted 4-H volunteer leader. She enjoyed sewing, quilting, cooking and baking and working in everyone's garden in addition to her own.

“ Mrs. Louella. My first memory of her was when I was a five-year-old attending the morning session of kindergarten at Hollywood Elementary School. That would have been 1978. She was my bus driver. On the "back-to-home bus trip", I would often crawl underneath the bus seats to "play" with my classmates despite her telling us not to. I was mischievous at that age.

Outside of being my bus driver in 1978-1979, our paths did not cross for many consecutive years. I last recall speaking to her briefly my senior year of high school up in Saluda (our paths had crossed, finally). Wow! I started off my school career with Mrs. Louella (in kindergarten) and then went about 12 years before speaking to her again (at the end of my school career)! Quite a time gap. Now, that is not a statement of criticism, just a statement of fact. There was no animosity between us. It was just odd how that situation turned out.

I know Mrs. Louella was a mainstay in the Hollywood School community of Saluda County. She was an icon, a fixture. Her absence will take time for us to adjust.

When I return home to visit, many iconic faces that I grew up with are absent - June Etheridge, Leonard Wallace, Wyman Banks, Bob White, Allen Hipp, Talton Rinehart, Margaret Power, Wally Matthews, Nelson Gentry, Floyd Hodge, Earl Berry, Bobby Ruff, Mike Price, Evelyn Morris, and many others. Mrs. Louella is now definitely part of the listing above.

With that said, I feel compelled to state that, as a current out-of-state resident, I sense that my home community is not what it once was - a thriving community in northeast Saluda County. With the lack of good-paying job opportunities in and near Saluda, many of the younger residents are leaving the county to pursue financial betterment (can't blame them, I am one of them, too). With so few younger folks remaining to replace these legacy citizens that are departing this life, I kind of/sort of sense that the Hollywood School

community is not a flourishing as it once was.

Now, I hope I am wrong. I see that the public schools are expanding, and new facilities are being built. I am happy to see that and hope that many jobs are produced as a result.

Perhaps I should not complain about losing iconic community residents. Such is life. As we grow older, it is a fact of life that we are all going to lose loved ones. Again, that is just part of life. For those of us left, it is our responsibility to build upon the legacy these people established for us.

And, Mrs. Louella left an indelible impression with her legacy! Rest in peace, Mrs. Louella. When my time is up here in this life, I would not be surprised to see Mrs. Louella waiting for me at those pearly gates with a school bus ready to drive me to my mansion in glory!
