He found so much joy in cultivating plants and sharing his knowledge with others, as well as providing lots of fresh fruits and vegetables to his family and friends. Another passion that he shared with his family was playing the ukulele and singing. Later in his life, he carved many ukuleles and gave them to family and friends.

In addition to his business, hobbies, and gardening pursuits, Mr. Padgett was a professional boxer, showcasing his determination and skill in the ring. He also devoted time to volunteering with the local humane society, advocating for animal welfare and creating a welcoming environment for pets and their potential adopters.

One of the highlights of Mr. Padgett's life was a transformative trip to the Holy Land, which deepened his faith and left a lasting impact on his outlook on life.
