Morris Lander Davenport, 81, died Friday, January 29, 2016 at his residence.

Born in Newberry County and a son of the late Jess Lander and Jessie Mae Medlin Davenport, he was the husband of Marian Undeen "Deanie" Underwood Davenport. Mr. Davenport served in the US Army during the Korean Conflict. He was a retired trooper first class with South Carolina Highway Patrol and was former Mayor of Saluda and Magistrate. He was a member of Saluda Baptist Church.
