Roy Wilson Rogers, 79, passed away Saturday, January 23, 2021 at Self Regional Medical Center.

Born in Ridge Spring, he was the son of the late Clyde and Helen Proctor Rogers, and the husband of Vicky Sanders Rogers. He was a homebuilder and member of Salem Baptist Church. After graduating from Hollywood High in 1960, he served with the National Guard and United States Army Reserve. 
