I can vividly recall Mrs. Sara during her days of attending those Little League baseball games back in mid-1980s. For two consecutive years, Schanen and I were on the same team - the Tigers - coached by James Guy Sample (head coach), the late Talton Rinehart (equipment coach), and her husband, Snap Miller (assistant coach). The second year, Frank Bethea would replace Mr. Talton.

She did not miss a game to my knowledge. Mrs. Sara was always "there" to see her husband coach and her son play shortstop and pitch.

In addition, I remember that Mrs. Sara was heavily involved with PACE (the parents' organization at Hollywood Elementary/Middle School) during Schanen's years at Hollywood. I can still see her and Mrs. Grant and one other lady working that supply desk on wheels. They were selling pencils, pens, and other school supplies to students at discount prices.

For many years, Mrs. Sara was a loyal customer to my mom. She was a regular at my mom's hair salon. My family greatly appreciated her dedication to being a "bread and butter" customer.

The last time I recall seeing Mrs. Sara was at the Chick-fil-a in Lexington around 15 years ago. My mom, niece, and nephew were there, too. Mrs. Sara recognized me before I recognized her. We engaged in conversation. Mr. Snap showed up. Then, my mom showed up and conversed a while. It was a pleasant moment for all of us.

In closing, may God grant you the "peace that passes understanding" during this challenging time. While we are sad to lose her physical presence, we are happy that she is no longer

suffering.
