Sherman Lee McNuer was born September 13, 1932 in Saluda County, SC, to the late Johnny Joseph and Bertha "Babe" Dickert McNuer. Lee went to be with the Lord on Monday, January 27, 2014.

Preceding him in death were one sister and four brothers: Myrtle M. Willis, Julian Mack, John Henry McNuer, Alan McNuer and Edward "Ed" McNure.
