Truman Ernest Trotter, 92, died Thursday, June 4, 2015 at Saluda Nursing Center.

Born in Saluda County and a son of the late Ernest B. and Leona Rodgers Trotter, he was the husband of the late Arzelle Dorn Trotter. Mr. Trotter was a US Army veteran of WWII and was a barber and owner of Saluda Barber Shop. He was a former Saluda Town Councilman, a member of the Saluda Civitan Club and American Legion Post 65 and he was a charter member of Saluda Baptist Church.
