Wilbur Wright Scurry, 61, died June 26, 2019 at his home in Saluda, SC.

A native of Saluda, he was the son of the late James Wendell and Vadis Dorn Scurry, and husband to Patricia "Patti" Henderson Scurry. He was the owner/operator of Scurry Mechanical in Saluda.

Surviving are his wife, Patti, two sons, Jim Scurry of Washington, D.C. and Will Scurry of Saluda, a brother, James D. Scurry of Columbia, a sister, Rebecca Hastings of Saluda, mother-in-law Shirley Henderson of Saluda, and a niece, Amy Hastings of Saluda.

Wilbur loved his family, his town and his animal companion, Molly his dog who predeceased him. He had a kind heart and a mischievous behavior and loved to play jokes on those that he loved.

“ First, my family and I want to send along our condolences on the loss of one of Saluda's more iconic and recognizable citizens.

Next, I can still vividly recall Wilbur coming out to my family's residence since the 1980's to work on various electrical issues (microwave oven, installing light fixtures, installing ceiling fans, etc.). I can still remember him installing a new central HVAC unit to our house in the early 1990's followed by the unit's fan motor several years later. I was often the one with whom he corresponded during those house calls.

Wilbur was always polite and humble to me and my relatives. He often would joke with my dad. And, oh, could those two ever joke! We liked Wilbur!

I was privileged to actually perform a service for him during the late 80's/early 90's. At that time, I worked for Mr. Frank Hite (lawn cutting services). I mowed Wilbur's yard multiple times that summer. In my mind, I can still distinctly recall his residence on the Denny Hwy.

Even though I have not seen him in over a double digit number of years, I know I will miss him as will my mom and dad. As a side note, he performed a lot of electrical work on my mother's beauty shop, Belle Dame Beauty Salon. Mom greatly appreciated Wilbur and his staff.

One of the drawbacks of living out of state (and traveling across the country) with my job, is that I often do not hear about what is happening in Saluda. I usually check Ramey's web site weekly to see if anyone I know (or knew) passed away. So, I appreciate Ramey hosting a web site. That is how I came to find out about the loss of Wilbur.

In closing, over the last 10 years or so, I heard Wilbur's health was in a state of decline. I cannot recall at this moment what malady of the body Wilbur had, but I remember it was degenerative. While he

will be missed, I know that we are all happy to take solace in the fact that he is no longer in a constant state of physical suffering. Instead of choosing to fret about his passing, I elect to be happy that my family and I were privileged to be blessed by his presence and services during his lifetime.
